- Actively measuring and reporting on our environmental impact, sustainability, and mitigation efforts, this includes measuring our Greenhouse Gas emissions, along with our water, energy, and waste footprints.
- Pioneering sustainability reporting and adhering to the highest global reporting standards.
- Enhancing our sustainability efforts, including our reporting, in a more effective, stakeholder-focused, and comprehensive manner.

### **Partnerships and collaboration:**

Build networks and alliances, and foster collaborations and partnerships with diverse local and international organizations to initiate and support environmental stewardship and sustainability initiatives within our sector and beyond.

We are committed to enhancing awareness of our environmental management policy and its impacts among both internal and external stakeholders. This includes:

- **Internal Stakeholder Communication:** Regularly updating employees on environmental policies, initiatives, and performance through workshops, training sessions, and internal communications channels.
- **External Stakeholder Communication:** Engaging with external stakeholders, including customers, suppliers, and the community, through targeted outreach, public reports, and sustainability updates.

#### **Environmental Culture:**

- Promoting 'Green' corporate culture and eco-friendly behavior within Aramex by increasing employees' awareness of their individual and collective environmental impact and encouraging the adoption of environmentally sustainable practices, including recycling and energy and resource-saving, both at home and in the office.

### **Active Carbon Footprint Management:**

- Committing to LEED certification (where possible) and ISO 14001 environmental management systems for our facilities in most of our operations, to ensure the effectiveness and efficiency of our ongoing environmental actions.
- Continuing our investment in clean technologies and renewable energy across our operations and infrastructure where available and regulations permit.
- Monitoring and managing energy consumption to reduce environmental impact and operational costs.

### **Environmental Compliance:**

- Expanding and ensuring environmental compliance within our network, as well as general compliance with international and local laws and regulations.
- Conducting regular reviews of environmental performance.
- Respecting and complying with local, national, and international legal and environmental protection laws, regulations, and standards to mitigate negative environmental impact including de-forestation and bio-diversity.
- Oversight of environmental performance and impact by an ESG Committee, comprised of the management team, which reports directly to the Board of Directors.

- Working to reduce pollution of all kinds within and due to our operations and value chain.
- Improving waste management within and beyond our operations by fostering a "Reduce, Reuse and Recycle" mentality.

- Reducing our waste output and expanding our recycling initiatives.
- Adopting a life-cycle assessment to map value chain impacts.

- Company-wide training on environmental awareness and risk management, covering response protocols for all environmental aspects, which also integrates all relevant environmental standards and includes the distribution of our internal Green Handbook. All our pouches are degradable, reflecting our commitment to sustainability. We have nine solar power plants expanding our renewable energy sourcing, with a commitment to expand renewable energy investments where available and regulations permit
- Tested and adopted electric vehicles as a greener alternative for our fleet, and shifting to cleaner fuels depending on what
  is available per market.
